1. Project Overview	
☐ Confirm project type: New construction / Re-roof / Preventive maintenance	
☐ Identify roofing system type: Single-ply, Built-up, Modified Bitumen, Protected Membrane, Green Roof

$\square$ Identify project stage (pre-installation, post-installation, warranty check, etc.)	
2. Site Conditions & Preparation	
☐ Ensure roof surface is clean, dry, and free of debris.	
☐ Verify electrical continuity between membrane and substrate.	
☐ Confirm all roof drains, scuppers, and terminations are accessible.	
☐ Review safety and access requirements (ladders, tie-offs, escorts).	
☐ Identify sensitive equipment areas requiring protection.	
3. System Requirements	
☐ Verify compatible testing method: Low-voltage, High-voltage, Moisture scanning.	
☐ Confirm testing coverage area and sequencing with HGI technician.	
☐ Review test boundaries, penetrations, and expansion joints.	
☐ Ensure electrical power and water source availability (if required).	

#### 4. Documentation & Communication

	□ Provide up-to-date roof drawings or as-builts.	
	☐ Establish point-of-contact for site coordination.	
	□ Determine report recipients (contractor, owner, warranty provider).	
	☐ Confirm documentation format: PDF, CAD overlay, annotated images.	
	$\square$ Schedule a post-test review meeting to discuss findings and next steps.	
5. Post-Test Actions		
	□ Review report with contractor or roofing consultant.	
	☐ Address any identified breaches or moisture areas promptly.	
	□ Retest after repairs to confirm watertightness.	
	☐ Archive results for warranty and compliance records.	
	□ Schedule periodic integrity checks as part of ongoing maintenance.	

### 6. Bonus Tips from HGI Experts

- Test early catching issues before overburden or ballast saves time and cost.
- Coordinate with trades—testing should occur after roof installation but before final finishes.
- Document everything—maps and images protect all stakeholders.
- Plan for re-verification—annual or biannual ELD testing extends roof life.
